SSA Basic Facts

In 2019 over 70 million Americans received approximately \$1.03 trillion in Social Security benefits. Over 74% of the recipients are Retired workers and their dependents; about 14% are Disabled workers and their dependents; and the remaining beneficiaries receive Survivors Benefits.

Over half of the workforce has no private pension coverage. Over a third of the workforce has no savings set aside specifically for retirement.
